- **Tender Accepted for Former Perth Patrol Yard Property:** Council has passed a motion authorizing a transaction between the county and Kevin Cassell for the sale of the former Perth Patrol Yard at 110 Wilson. St. W. in Perth. The land is approximately 3.5 acres in size and includes a six-bay garage, two-storey office, sand dome and salt shed with two entrances onto Wilson Street West. The county vacated the property last December and moved operations to its new facility at Christie Lake Road behind the administration offices.
