

**THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF LANARK
BY-LAW NO. 2019-34**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO ADOPT AN ACCESS TO COUNTY ROADS POLICY
FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF LANARK**

WHEREAS the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c 25, Section 5(3), as amended provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by by-law;

WHEREAS the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c 25, Section 35, as amended provides that a municipality may pass by-laws removing or restricting the common law right of passage by the public over a highway and the common law right of access to the highway by an owner of land abutting a highway;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the County of Lanark deems it necessary and desirable to regulate the construction and alteration of entrances, private roads, or other facilities that permit access to County roads and to provide for the issuing of permits related thereto, by adopting the County Road Access Policy, attached hereto as Schedule 'A' and forming part of this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Lanark enacts as follows:

1. The Access to County Roads Policy is hereby adopted and attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.
2. This By-Law shall come into full force and effect on November 13, 2019.
3. That By-Law 2004-28 is hereby repealed.
4. Should any sections of this by-law, including any section or part of any schedules attached hereto be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be ultra vires, the remaining sections shall nevertheless remain valid and binding.
